Privacy Policy of the Unified Interpreting Corpus (UNIC) Platform

1. Privacy policy statement

Pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of the General Data Protection Regulation (Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016), data subjects are informed that any personal data provided to or in any case obtained by Alma Mater Studiorum – University of Bologna will be processed for the purposes of allowing access to the UNIC and managing the related activities. The data will be processed by specifically authorised persons, using also computerised means, in the manner and to the extent necessary to achieve the aforementioned purposes, including in the event of sharing the data with third parties.

The legal basis for the data processing is found in Article 6 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679, paragraph 1(b) (processing for the performance of a contract) and (e) (processing for reasons of public interest). The provision of said data is essential in order to access the UNIC, and refusal to provide said data will make it impossible to use the UNIC.

Data subjects have the rights referred to in Articles 15 et seq. of the aforementioned Regulation (EU) 2016/679, in particular, the right to access their data, to request and obtain the rectification, erasure or restriction on the processing of their data, as well as the right to object to the processing of their data. They may exercise these rights by emailing Alma Mater Studiorum – University of Bologna at privacy@unibo.it. Data subjects who believe that their personal data have been processed in violation of the requirements of the Regulation may file a complaint with the Italian Data Protection Authority, as provided for by Article 77 of the above Regulation, or seek an effective judicial remedy (Article 79 of the Regulation).

2. Analysis of anonymised user statistics

In order to conduct user research as part of the operation and further development of UNIC, user behaviour is analysed in terms of the number of consultations and downloads as recorded on the UNIC platform. This provides information on UNIC usage statistics (access figures) and the paths users take through the system. By analysing this data anonymously, UNIC staff hopes to gain insights into the needs and potential problems associated with the use of UNIC and thus be able to continuously improve the service.
